In the August 8 article, Former Fresno State student finds empowerment through #MeToo protest, there were four paragraphs detailing an interaction between the former student and the Fresno State Police Department (FSPD) in August 2019.

The former student states that the investigation was held by the FSPD, but a Fresno State spokesperson states that an investigation was not held by the FSPD due to it being out of their jurisdiction.

The claim of threats over social media to the former student by an unnamed man in August 2019 were reported and looked into by the FSPD.

The former student also states that she was berated by an investigator "Officer Flores" during the investigation that took place. A Fresno State spokesperson says that there was no "Officer Flores" on the FSPD staff in August 2019.

The former student was unable to name any other officer who may have been involved in the interaction.
