October 4th, 2022 Rashad was a victim of a hit and run incident in front of Hoover High near the intersection of First and Barstow. After courageously fighting for his life for a week on October 10th, 2022 Rashad tragically succumbed to his injuries. Rashad's parents and family are left devastated and are demanding answers and justice.

After hidding and protecting her identity for 16 days Fresno Police Department finally released the name of the driver.
