**7.3 Action Item: Appointment of Justice, Equity, Diversity, and Inclusion (20 minutes)**

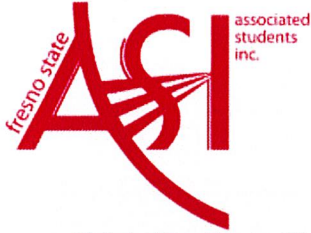
